Tier 1; Core Vendors

For Vendors who can commit in advance to attending all markets;

Payment will be in full in advance;

Available to all food and produce vendors including food plants or seeds;

Total booth fee for the season; \$500.00

Tier 2; Essential Vendors

For vendors who can commit to attending specified markets but less than a full season;

Payment can be in full in advance or monthly in advance;

Available to all food and produce and food-plants or seed vendors;

Total per market day \$ 25.00

Membership additional; \$35.00; required

Tier 3; Key Vendors

For Vendors who schedule month-by-month by availability and as regulations allow;

Payment will be in advance when scheduling is confirmed;

Available to all food; non-food consumables; artists and artisans;

Membership additional; \$35.00; required

Total per market day \$25.00

Tier 4; Welcome Vendors

Scheduling is one week in advance, minimum, on an availability basis;

Payment will be in advance when scheduling is confirmed;

Available for non-members;

Available for food, non-food consumable; artists and artisans;

Membership additional; \$35.00; optional

Total per market day \$50.00

Tier 5; Opportunity Vendors

Scheduling is one-week in advance minimum;

Payment is on-site on arrival at the market set-up;

Available to vendors who do not have a full market set-up and may sell from their vehicle in a designated area of the market site; or as directed by the manager.

Available to food vendors only; Available to non-members only; Total per market day \$50.00

Please note; this category is aimed at occasional vendors such as gardeners who have a some-time availability of produce, plants, etc., but are not regular vendors; or for vendors to have an opportunity to do a trial-run at being at the market. Applicants should consult closely with the manager when exploring this possibility.
